HB 1037 proposes to amend Compete with Canada Film Act (68 O.S. § 3623 et. seq.) This measure proposes to modify definitions relating to certain qualifying expenditures and also increases the percentage of expenditures eligible for the rebate from seventeen percent (17%) to thirty-five percent (35%). Further, it increases the annual fiscal year maximum rebates paid from Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) to Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000).
