Section 3 of the measure proposes to amend 47 O.S. § 1135.5 by reauthorizing an Eastern Red Cedar Tree special license plate.

This bill proposes to create the Oklahoma Woody Biomass Energy Initiative Act of 2011. It creates until July 1, 2014, the Woody Biomass Energy Initiative Council to develop an Oklahoma Renewable Woody Biomass Energy Usage Plan. Section 3 of the measure proposes to amend 47 O.S. § 1135.5(B)(46) by reauthorizing an Eastern Red Cedar Tree special license plate.

House Bill 2686, effective July 1, 2010, previously amended 47 O.S. § 1135.5(B)(45) by creating the "Eastern Red Cedar Tree" special license plate for persons wishing to demonstrate support for "Eastern Red Cedar Tree". The annual fee is \$35 and is in addition to all other motor vehicle registration fees. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23) of the annual fee shall be deposited into the Eastern Red Cedar Revolving Fund created in Section 8 of that measure.

The Tax Commission did not receive the statutorily required one hundred prepaid applications for the "Eastern Red Cedar Tree" special license plate within one hundred and eighty (180) days of July 1, 2010. House Bill 1486 would reauthorize creation of such special license plate and allow persons wishing to demonstrate support for an "Eastern Red Cedar Tree" special license plate another opportunity to comply with the statutory requirements necessary before the Tax Commission is permitted to develop and issue special license plates.
