PROPOSAL: Amendatory 63 O.S. § 2843.2

For purposes of allocation of prepaid wireless 911 fees, the measure modifies eligible governing body to include not only those governing bodies that have imposed and are collecting the nine-one-one emergency wireless telephone fee¹ but also the substate planning district designated by those counties that have not assessed a nine-one-one emergency wireless telephone fee. Also, the measure requires the substate planning district to hold in a separate escrow account all prepaid wireless 911 fees paid on behalf of counties in its region that have not assessed a nine-one-one fee until such time as the county votes to assess the fee or develops wireless nine-one-one service pursuant to Section 2849 of Title 63. Further, it modifies the formula to determine each governing body's share of collected prepaid wireless 911 fees; providing that the share for each governing body shall be determined by dividing the population of the governing body by the total population of the state.
