This measure creates the *Transparency in Agency Lobbying Act*. Every legislative liaison<sup>1</sup> must file reports with the Secretary of State once the estimated amount of time exceeds five (5) hours a week. The reports shall be subject to the *Oklahoma Open Records Act*.

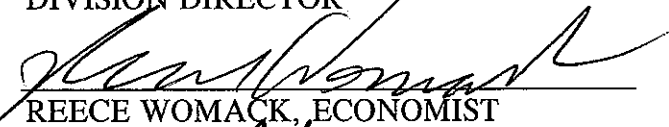
