PROPOSAL: New Law

HB 1452 creates the *Oklahoma Legislative Open Records and Meetings Act*. All records of legislative entities¹ are open to any person for inspection, copying, and reproduction. This includes work product directly related to the creation of legislation. Notice and an agenda are to be posted prior to a meeting of a legislative body². Meetings of a legislative body will be open to the public subject to certain exceptions. An oversight committee³ will oversee appeals and complaints involving this Act.

¹ "Legislative entity" means the House of Representatives, Senate or the Legislative Service Bureau.

² "Legislative body" means a majority of the members of a legislative chamber. Legislative body also means the majority of the members of a committee of the House of Representatives or the Senate that provides recommendations to the chamber as to the disposition of legislation and that meets in public at least once during a legislative session.

³ "Oversight committee" means a committee designated by the Speaker of the House or the President Pro Tempore of the Senate with the responsibility of adjudicating rules-related matters for the respective chamber.
