SB 986 proposes to amend 51 O.S. § 24A.5 by increasing the maximum record copying fee for any record request not otherwise prescribed by law from \$.25 to \$.50 per page and the maximum certified record copying fee from \$1.00 to \$2.00. Any record copying and certified record copying fees collected are deposited into the Tax Commission Fund.
