PROPOSAL: Amendatory 47 O.S. § 7-606

The measure adds provisions for municipal police departments enforcing the Compulsory Insurance Law by providing that for charges relating to citations for failing to comply with this law which are to be filed in municipal court, the law enforcement agency issuing the citation may deposit the license plate with their own agency. It further provides that the municipal police department that is storing the license plate must enter the seized license plate number into the statewide database maintained by the plan administrator. It also outlines the period in which proof of insurance verification may be provided without application of the administrative fee. If not provided within the stated interval, regardless of whether the person has the required coverage, the administrative fee is applicable.
