PROPOSAL: New Law

Section 6 of SB 9311 proposes a new income tax checkoff to allow the donation of individual and corporate income tax refunds for the benefit of programs to recruit, train and supervise volunteers as Court Appointed Special Veteran Advocates effective for tax year 2020 income tax forms. If a taxpayer makes a donation in error, the taxpayer may file a claim for refund at any time within three (3) years from the due date of the tax return.

This measure also creates the Income Tax Checkoff Revolving Fund for Court Appointed Special Veteran Advocates in the State Treasurer's office to be administered by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs.
